أَنْعَمْتَ

on them You have bestowed (Your) Favors (of) those (The) path

وَلَا عَلَيْهِمْ

غَيْرِ

and not on themselves those who earned (Your) wrath not (of)

الْمَغْضُوبِ

الضَّالِّينَ

(of) those who go astray

The Way of those on whom You have bestowed Your Grace [1], not (the way) of those who earned Your Anger [2] (i.e. those who knew the Truth, but did not follow it) nor of those who went astray (i.e. those who did not follow the Truth out of ignorance and error). [3], [4].

[2] (V.1:7) Narrated 'Adi bin Hatim رضي الله عنه; I asked Allah's Messenger ﷺ, about the Statement of Allah: 1. غير المغضوب عليهم "Ghairil-maghfubu 'alaihim (not the way of those who earned Your Anger)," he ﷺ replied "They are the Jews". And 2. ولا الصالين "Walad dallin (nor of those who went astray)," he ﷺ replied: "The Christians, and they are the ones who went astray" [This Hadith is quoted by At-Tirmidhi and Musnad Abu Dawud].
